The City of Denton imposes at 7% hotel occupancy tax per Chapter 10: Finance and Taxation of its municipal code. Reporting and payment of the city's 7% occupancy tax is made by the property owner directly to the City of Denton using its required reporting form. New lodging properties must contact the city's Finance department before collecting and paying the imposed 7% occupancy tax.
